## ORDER GRANTING TEMPORARY STAY

This is an appeal from a district court order granting a motion to suppress respondent's interrogation statements. Appellant has filed an emergency motion to stay trial pending appeal. Having considered appellant's motion and supporting documents, we conclude that a temporary stay is warranted pending our receipt and consideration of any opposition from respondent and a determination on whether good cause to entertain the appeal exists. NRAP 8; see NRS 177.015(2).

Accordingly, we stay the trial in State of Nevada v. Brown, Second Judicial District Court Case No. CR17-1851, pending further order of the court. Respondent shall have 7 days from the date of this order to file in the Court of Appeals and serve a response to the motion for stay. Appellant shall have 5 days from the date that respondent's response is served to file in the Court of Appeals and serve any reply. Briefing on the good cause issue is proceeding concurrently in the Supreme Court.

It is so ORDERED.
