This original petition for a writ of prohibition challenges the Nevada Commission on Judicial Discipline's jurisdiction over hearing masters. Petitioner has moved to stay the Commission's upcoming public hearing pending our consideration of the petition. Having considered petitioner's motion, we conclude that a temporary stay is warranted pending our receipt and consideration of any opposition from respondent. NRAP 8.
