MEMORANDUM AND DECLARATION OF STEVEN S. OWNES

I, STEVEN S. OWENS, am the attorney assigned to prosecute this appeal.

The State is requesting a thirty (30) day extension of time in which to file its

Answering Brief pursuant to NRAP 31.

This is an appeal from a district court order denying Appellant's Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus entered on May 18, 2018. Appellant filed a notice of appeal on April 27, 2018. Appellant filed his first motion requesting a fourteen (14) day extension to file his docketing statement on June 11, 2018. Appellant filed a second motion requesting a thirty (30) day extension to file his opening brief on September 13, 2018. Each of Appellant's motions for additional time was granted without opposition from Respondent. Appellant's Opening Brief was not filed until October 31, 2018. NRAP 31(a)(1)(B) requires that the State file its Respondent's Brief by November 30, 2018, as confirmed by this Court's order dated October 31, 2018.
