DECLARATION OF WILLIAM M. WATERS

- 1. I am an attorney duly licensed to practice law in the State of Nevada and the Deputy Public Defender assigned to represent VERNON NEWSON, JR. in this appeal; I am familiar with the procedural history of this case.
- On direct appeal a three-judge panel of this Court issued a
 published decision reversing Newson's murder conviction but
 affirming his Child Abuse, Neglect or Endangerment
 convictions. See Newson v. State, 135 Nev. Adv. Op. 50 (Nev.
 Sup. Ct. 2019).
- 3. On October 28, 2019, both Newson and the State filed Petitions for Rehearing of the Panel's decision. The State's petition focused on the panel's decision to reverse Newson's Murder conviction while Newson's petition focused on the panel's decision to affirm his Child Abuse, Neglect or Endangerment convictions.
- 4. On November 20, 2019, the panel filed an Order denying both Newson's and the State's respective Petitions.
- 5. On November 27, 2019, the State filed a Petition for *En Banc*Reconsideration of the panel decision regarding the Murder

- conviction.
- 6. On December 2, 2019, Newson filed his own Petition for En Banc Reconsideration of the panel decision regarding the Child Abuse, Neglect or Endangerment convictions.
- 7. On January 8, 2020, this Court denied the State's Petition for *En Banc* Reconsideration and ordered the State to file an Answer to Newson's Petition for *En Banc* Reconsideration within 14 days from the date of the Court's order.
- 8. The State filed its Answer on January 22, 2020.
- 9. In addressing Newson's argument that the panel's decision to affirm Newson's convictions for Child Abuse, Neglect or Endangerment directly contradicted this Court's prior precedent in Clay v. Eighth Judicial Dist. Court, 129 Nev. 445 (2013), the State offers new arguments not raised in its original Respondent's Answering Brief.
- 10.Additionally, in its Answer to Newson's Petition the State makes certain factual representations regarding what the Panel concluded which is belied by the decision itself and the record below.

11. NRAP 40A prohibits submission of a Reply in Support of a

Petition for En Banc Reconsideration without leave of this

Honorable Court. Accordingly, Petitioner is submitting the

instant Motion for Leave to file a Reply in Support of Petition

for En Banc Reconsideration.

12. Effective prosecution of Newson's Petition for En Banc

Reconsideration requires that Newson be allowed to reply to the

State's critical factual and legal claims raised in its Answer.

13. Finally, undersigned counsel is mindful of the Court's desire

for timely resolution of matters before the court. Therefore,

Counsel asserts he can file any Reply brief, if granted by this

Court, within 7 days.
