ORDER

This matter involves legal questions certified to this court under NRAP 5 by the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit. Appellant previously filed a motion to stay briefing in this matter pending the Ninth Circuit's resolution of his petition for panel and en banc rehearing of the certification order. This court granted the unopposed motion, suspending briefing pending further order of this court and directing appellant to file a report informing this court of the status of the petition for rehearing.
