Provide a brief description of the nature of the action and result in the District Court, including the type of Order being appealed and the relief granted by the District Court: The Appellant proceeded to jury trial on September 11, 12, 13, 14 and 15, 2018 for the allegations of Count I Child Abuse, Neglect or Endangerment, a category B felony violation of NRS 200.508(1); Count II Battery Constituting Domestic Violence, a category B felony violation of NRS 200.485(2); Counts III through V– Child Abuse, Neglect or Endangerment, a category B felony violation of NRS 200.508(1); Count VI Child Abuse, Neglect or Endangerment, a category B felony violation of NRS 207.190(2); Counts VII and VIII Child Abuse, Neglect or Endangerment, a category B felony violation of NRS 200.508(1).

Appellant was found guilty by the jury on September 15, 2018 of Counts 1, 2, 3 and 5.

Counts 1, 3 and 5 are Child Abuse, Neglect or Endangerment, a category B felony violation of NRS 200.508(1). Appellant was sentenced to imprisonment in the Nevada Department of Corrections for Counts 1, 3 and 5– for a minimum period of Nineteen (19) months and a maximum sentence of forty-eight (48) months, all Counts running concurrently. This sentence was suspended and Ms. Nash was placed on Probation for an indeterminate amount of time, not to exceed Three (3) Years. For Count 2, Battery Constituting Domestic Violence, a category B felony violation of NRS 200.485(2), Ms. Nash was sentenced to Credit for Time Served. Appellant now seeks to appeal the sentence in the Judgment of Conviction filed May 7, 2018.
