APPELLANT'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

DUE TO TRANSCRIPTION DELAYS

COMES NOW, Appellant LISA ANN NASH, by and through her counsel of record, THERESA RISTENPART, ESQ., and hereby requests this Court enter an Order extending the due date of Ms. Nash's Opening Brief by sixty days (60) days, from November 26, 2018 to January 26, 2019.

The extension is necessary for the following reasons:

1. Transcripts were requested on August 2, 2018 from Court Reporters Dana Tavaglione and Sharon Howard.
2. Transcripts and Court Reporter Certificates were due by September 10, 2018.
3. On September 20, 2018, Appellant Counsel communicated with Court Reporter Dana Tavaglione who replied that she needed only ten (10) days to complete transcription. On October 3, 2018, Appellant Counsel contacted Court Reporter

2 responded.

3 4. On October 3, 2018, Appellant Counsel contacted Court Reporter Sharon Howard
4 who indicated she would begin transcribing in about a week.

5 5. The delay in reviewing these transcripts has currently put Appellant Counsel thirty-
6 seven (37) days behind schedule and neither court reporter has provided an expected
7 completion date.

8 For these reasons, we respectfully request that the Court extend the due date of Ms.
9 Nash's Opening Brief by sixty days (60) days, from November 26, 2018 to January 26, 2019.

10 FURTHERMORE, pursuant to NRS 239B.030, the undersigned hereby affirms this
