By virtue of a Jury Verdict, DEFT HONEA ADJUDGED GUILTY of SEXUAL ASSAULT OF A MINOR UNDER SIXTEEN YEARS OF AGE (F). COURT ORDERED, in addition to the \$25.00 Administrative Assessment fee, a \$150.00 DNA Analysis fee including testing to determine genetic markers, and \$3.00 DNA Collection fee, Deft. SENTENCED to a TERM of LIFE in the Nevada Department of Corrections (NDC), with the opportunity of parole AFTER a MINIMUM TERM of TWENTY-FIVE (25) YEARS SERVED, with SIX HUNDRED NINETY-TWO (692) DAYS credit for time served. COURT FURTHER ORDERED, a special SENTENCE OF LIFETIME SUPERVISION is imposed to commence upon release from any term of probation, parole or imprisonment pursuant to NRS 176.0931, Deft. to register as a sex offender in accordance with NRS 179D.460 within 48 hours of release from custody or imprisonment.

Ms. Rhoades present, all other parties present as before. With regard to Deft's. Motion for Setting of Appeal Bail, Ms. McNeill argued she believes the jury was improperly instructed; the victim freely admitted the acts were consensual. Ms. Kollins argued the victim was unable to give consent due to her age; she does not believe Deft's. appeal will be successful. Additional argument by Ms. McNeill. COURT STATED ITS FINDINGS, and FURTHER ORDERED, Deft's. Motion GRANTED, the Appeal Bail SET at \$100,000.00; Deft. to is to transfer his bail from the Bondsman to an Appeal Bail. Deft. is to stay out of trouble and comply with any bail requirements.
