

*ORDER REMOVING FROM SETTLEMENT PROGRAM AND
REINSTATING DEADLINES FOR FILING REQUIRED DOCUMENTS*

On October 23, 2018, this court entered an order granting a motion to withdraw as counsel of record for appellants/cross-respondents (appellants). Our order directed appellants to retain new counsel and cause new counsel to file a notice of appearance with this court within 30 days. If appellants would not be retaining new counsel, appellants were directed to notify this court in writing of that fact within the same time period. As of the date of this order, appellants have not responded to this court's order. Accordingly, we remove this appeal from the settlement program and reinstate all applicable deadlines. *See* NRAP 16(a).

We direct the clerk of this court to provide appellant Fred Nassiri with instructions and notice regarding deadlines applicable to pro se cases. Appellant Nassiri shall file all required documents and comply with all applicable deadlines contained therein. Respondent is not required to file responsive pleadings unless ordered to do so by the court. *See* NRAP 46A(c).

Finally, we note that no statute or court rule authorizes an entity to represent itself or to be represented by a nonlawyer in this court.

State v. Stu's Bail Bonds, 115 Nev. 436, 436 n.1, 991 P.2d 469, 470 n.1 (1999); *See also Salman v. Newell*, 110 Nev. 1333, 1336, 885 P.2d 607, 608 (1994) (trustee who is not an attorney cannot represent trust in either district court or supreme court, and trusts cannot proceed in proper person in supreme court). Accordingly, The Nassiri Living Trust may not file briefs without counsel. NRAP 46A(b)(2).

It is so ORDERED.
