15 in the Nevada Department of Corrections, with credit for 0 days in predisposition
16 custody. This sentence was suspended and she was placed on probation for a
17 period of time not to exceed 60 months.

21 12. This appeal does not involve child custody or visitation.

15 **JUDGMENT OF CONVICTION**

16 The Defendant, having entered a plea of Guilty, and no legal reason or cause
17 existing to preclude entry of judgment against her, the Court rendered judgment as follows:

18 1. Upataua Diana Poasa, is guilty of the crime of Grand Larceny of Auto,
19 Less Than \$3500, a violation of NRS 205.228(2), a category C felony, as charged in Count
20 I of the Information.

21 2. She is punished by:

22 a) Imprisonment in the Nevada Department of Corrections for a
23 maximum term of thirty-four (34) months with a minimum parole eligibility of twelve (12)
24 months, with credit for zero (0) days time served as to Count I.

25 b) Payment of restitution to the victim in the amount of Eight
26 Hundred Dollars (\$800.00).

27 c) Payment to the Clerk of the Second Judicial District Court of
28 the following amounts:

1. Twenty-Five Dollar (\$25.00) administrative assessment fee; and
2. Three Dollar (\$3.00) administrative assessment for obtaining a biological specimen and conducting a genetic marker analysis; and
3. Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for legal representation; and
4. Sixty Dollar (\$60.00) chemical analysis fee; and
5. One Hundred Fifty Dollar (\$150.00) DNA Analysis fee.

1 Any fine, fee or administrative assessment imposed upon the Defendant as
2 reflected in this Judgment of Conviction constitutes a lien, as defined in Nevada Revised
3 Statutes (NRS 176.275). Should the Defendant not pay these fines, fees, or assessments,
4 collection efforts may be undertaken.

Defendant sworn and fully canvassed by the Court as to her rights, understanding of concurrent and consecutive sentences and possible penalties for the offense to which she pled.

State's counsel read aloud the charge to which the Defendant plead.

Court accepted plea after finding that the Defendant was freely, voluntarily and competently entering such pleas and had been fully advised by counsel.

Defense counsel requested the Defendant be release on her own recognizance in order to start paying restitution.

COURT reviewed the note provided by Pre-Trial Services prior to the hearing.

Defense counsel discussed the Defendant's pre-trial violation.

COURT admonished Defendant regarding the importance of her performance on pre-trial supervision.

COURT ORDERED the Defendant to cooperate with the Division of Parole and Probation in the preparation of a PSI.

COURT FURTHER ORDERED matter continued for entry of judgment, consideration of probation report and imposition of sentence; Defendant granted release on her own recognizance under Pre-Trial Services supervision.

Defendant remanded to the custody of the Sheriff.
