Attachment to Status Report:

The parties and their respective counsel participated in a settlement conference on January 23, 2019. The parties negotiated in good faith, including the exchange of offers and counteroffers. At the end of the scheduled session the case remained unresolved. The Settlement Judge adjourned the session but did not conclude the conference. The Settlement Judge encouraged the parties and their counsel to consider their respective positions and the positions of the other parties, all to the end of exploring whether the case may yet be resolved through further negotiations. The Settlement Judge will confer with the parties' counsel individually in fourteen (14) to sixteen (16) days to determine whether there could be more productive discussions about settlement or if the settlement conference process should be concluded and the case returned to the Court for further formal proceedings. The Settlement Judge will update this interim report in about four weeks, after he confers with counsel.
