*ORDER DIRECTING REPLY TO THE ANSWER
TO THE PETITION FOR REVIEW*

On April 13, 2020, appellant filed with the Court of Appeals a document entitled "Petition for Review," ostensibly seeking review by this court of the Order of Affirmance entered by the Court of Appeals on March 26, 2020. On April 14, 2020, the clerk transferred the petition to the Supreme Court, and on May 7, 2020, this court ordered respondent to file an answer to the petition. In its answer, respondent asserts that the petition for review is untimely "if it was supposed to be filed in the Supreme Court. Since it was not timely filed in the proper Court, it should be summarily denied." Appellant shall have 14 days from the date of this order within which to file and serve a reply to the assertion in respondent's answer that the petition is untimely. We stay issuance of the remittitur in this matter pending resolution of the petition for review.
