This is the second request for an extension for this Brief. Counsel for RDI had previously requested and been granted a two-week extension, changing the due date from the originally scheduled May 3, 2019 to May 17, 2019.

This request is not made to delay the proceedings. Counsel for RDI had surgery performed on May 9, 2019. She had anticipated such surgery would have only a small effect on her ability to work on this matter, and would not prevent completion by May 17, 2019, but this has not proven to be the case.
