ORDER

On April 5, 2022, this court entered an order granting appellant's motion to stay issuance of the remittitur until August 16, 2022, pending his petition to the United States Supreme Court for a writ of certiorari. Appellant has filed a notice informing this court that the time for filing the petition has been extended to August 20, 2022. Accordingly, the stay of the issuance of the remittitur is hereby extended until September 6, 2022. If the clerk of this court receives written notice by September 6, 2022, from the clerk of the United States Supreme Court that appellant has filed a petition for a writ of certiorari, the stay shall continue in effect until final disposition of the certiorari proceedings. If such notice is not received by September 6, 2022, the clerk shall issue the remittitur.
