ORDER TRANSFERRING TO COURT OF APPEALS

We previously informed the parties that this appeal may be assigned to the Court of Appeals of Nevada for disposition. *See Nev. Const. art. 6, § 4.* Because the appeal had been docketed before the effective date of amendments to the Nevada Rules of Appellate Procedure that allow the parties to address assignment of an appeal in their briefs, we provided the parties an opportunity to file a written statement explaining why this court should not assign this appeal to the court of appeals. Respondent has filed a statement suggesting that this court should retain this appeal.

Having considered respondent's statement, we direct the clerk of this court to assign this appeal to the court of appeals for disposition. The Nevada Rules of Appellate Procedure as amended on December 18, 2014, shall apply to all further proceedings in this appeal. *See In the Matter of the Amendment of the Nevada Rules of Appellate Procedure, ADKT No. 0501 (Order Amending Rules, December 18, 2014) (providing*
