ORDER DENYING MOTION

Appellant has filed a motion requesting a third extension of time to file the fast track statement in this appeal. When we granted appellant's prior request for an extension of time, we cautioned that no further extensions of time would be granted absent demonstration of "extreme need or merit." As support for the instant motion, appellant's counsel cites only the fact that he was out of the office during the holiday season on "pre planned time away." Because appellant has failed to demonstrate extreme need or merit warranting a third extension of time to file the fast track statement, the motion is denied. Appellant shall have until February 3, 2017, to file and serve the fast track statement and appendix. We caution appellant's counsel that failure to comply may result in the imposition of sanctions. *See* NRAP 3C(n).

It is so ORDERED.
