**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME
TO FILE PETITION FOR REHEARING**

Pending finalization of a settlement with respondent Treasure Island, LLC, appellant Rose, LLC requests a 45-day extension, through August 8, 2019, to file its petition for rehearing. *See* NRAP 31(b)(3). This is the first such request. Without the extension, the petition would be due June 24, 2019.

The extension is necessary because of the time it will take to finalize the parties' settlement. Rose is operating under a receivership in Colorado. Once executed, the settlement agreement must be submitted to the Colorado receivership court. Creditors of the receivership estate have an opportunity to object to the settlement, and the Colorado court has to consider any objections before approval.

In view of the anticipated resolution of this claim, Treasure Island represents that it does not oppose Rose's request for this extension.
