**ORDER**

This is an appeal and cross-appeal from a district court order regarding attorney fees and costs. On June 26, 2019, this court granted appellant/cross-respondent's motion to suspend briefing pending the resolution of a jurisdiction issue in the related appeal in Docket No. 76276. Specifically, appellant/cross-respondent indicated in its motion that if this court did not have jurisdiction in 76276, then it likely would not have jurisdiction in the instant appeal. This court's order directed appellant/cross-respondent to file status report in this appeal within 7 days of entry of an order resolving the jurisdiction issue in 76276.

On July 12, 2019, this court entered an order dismissing the appeal in 76276 for lack of jurisdiction. To date, appellant/cross-respondent has not filed a status report in this appeal. This court concluded in 76276, that the order challenged on appeal was not appealable as a final judgment. Accordingly, it appears that the order challenged in the instant appeal would not be appealable as a special order after final judgment or otherwise independently appealable, and this court may lack jurisdiction to consider this appeal. See NRAP 3A(b); *Brown v. MHC Stagecoach, LLC*, 129 Nev. 343, 347, 301 P.3d 850, 853 (2010) (this court may only consider appeals

that are authorized by statute or court rule). Appellant/cross-respondent and respondent/cross-appellant shall each have 14 days from the date of this order to file and serve a status report and to show cause why this appeal and cross-appeal should not be dismissed for lack of jurisdiction. Failure to demonstrate that this court has jurisdiction may result in the dismissal of this appeal and cross-appeal.

It is so ORDERED.
