This action arises out of a failed construction project that closed, incomplete, in 2008. A trial was held in February 2018 on subcontractors claims against the project's general contractors, including Appellant/Cross Respondent Helix Electric's claims against Cross Appellant/Respondent APCO. The district court entered a judgment denying relief to Helix Electric as to its claims against APCO, and that judgment was appealed by Helix Electric to this Court in Case No. 76276. The appeal in Case No. 76276 was subsequently dismissed by this Court.

In this appeal, Helix Electric and APCO both challenge the
