Deft.'s Motion for Leave to File Affidavit and Request for Issuance of Writ of Execution: Court noted that it reviewed the file in this matter. The Deft. was tried before a Jury in January 2002 and convicted of Count 1 - Attempt Sexual Assault with a Minor Under Fourteen; Count 2 - Sexual Assault with a Minor Under Fourteen; Count 3, was NOT GUILTY. Deft. appealed the Judgment of Conviction (JOC) in 2003; the Supreme Court AFFIRMED with LIMITED REMAND. The JOC incorrectly indicated that Deft. pled guilty when he was actually convicted by a jury so the matter was remanded for correction of the JOC. An Amended JOC was prepared and filed on February 9, 2005.

The Deft. then filed an Motion to Vacate, Set Aside, or Correct an Illegal Sentence; it was denied; the Order was filed December 1, 2016. The Deft. is appealing said ruling. COURT ORDERED, the Motion is DENIED.
