22 CASE APPEAL STATEMENT

23 1. Appellant, EDWARD SAMUEL PUNDYK.

24 2. This appeal is from a judgment of conviction entered on November 2,
25 2018, by the Honorable Connie J. Steinheimer, district judge.

26 3. The parties below were The State of Nevada, Plaintiff and EDWARD
SAMUEL PUNDYK, Defendant.

4. The parties herein are EDWARD SAMUEL PUNDYK, Appellant and The
State of Nevada, Respondent.

1 5. Counsel on appeal: For the Appellant, the Washoe County Public
2 Defender's Office and John Reese Petty, Chief Appellate Deputy, 350 South Center
3 Street, 5th Floor, Reno, Nevada 89520-0027, (775) 337-4827; and for the
4 Respondent, the Washoe County District Attorney's Office, One South Sierra
5 Street, Reno, Nevada 89501, (775) 337-5751.

7 6. Appointed counsel represented Appellant in the district court.

8 7. Appointed counsel represents Appellant on appeal.

9 8. The Washoe County Public Defender was court-appointed.

10 9. The charging document (Indictment) was filed on August 24, 2016.

11 10. A jury found Mr. Pundyk guilty but mentally ill of one count of murder
12 with the use of a deadly weapon, a violation of NRS 200.010, NRS 200.030 (Count
13 I), and NRS 193.165, a category A felony; and of one count of discharging a firearm
14 at or into an occupied structure, a violation of NRS 202.285, a category B felony
15 (Count II). The district court sentenced him to a term of life with the possibility of
16 parole after serving a minimum of 20 years in the Nevada Department of
17 Corrections, plus a consecutive term of imprisonment of 96 to 240 months for the
18 use of a deadly weapon on Count I, with credit for 1,123 days in predisposition
19 custody. On Count II the district court imposed a consecutive sentence of 12 to 60
20 months in the Nevada Department of Corrections.

23 11. This case has not previously been the subject of an appeal or writ
24 proceeding.
25

26 12. This appeal does not involve child custody or visitation.

16 The Defendant, having been found Guilty, but Mentally Ill, by a Jury, and no
17 sufficient cause being shown by Defendant as to why judgment should not be pronounced
18 against him, the Court renders judgment as follows:

19 That Edward Samuel Pundyk is guilty of the crimes of Murder with the Use of
20 a Deadly Weapon, a violation of NRS 200.010, NRS 200.030 and NRS 193.165, a
21 category A felony, as charged in Count I and Discharging a Firearm at or into Occupied
22 Structure, a violation of NRS 202.285, a category B felony as charged in Count II of the
23 Indictment, and that he be punished by imprisonment in the Nevada Department of
24 Corrections for the term of Life With the Possibility of Parole after twenty (20) years has
25 been served, with credit for one thousand one hundred twenty-three (1,123) days time
26 served, for Count I, with a consecutive term of imprisonment in the Nevada Department of
27 Corrections for maximum term of two hundred forty (240) months with the minimum parole
