
ORDER EXTENDING TEMPORARY AMENDMENT OF


Supreme Court Rule 217 provides for the creation and maintenance of interest-bearing trust accounts. Subsection 2(a) of that rule sets a minimum rate of interest payable upon any interest-bearing trust account at 0.70 percent. In light of the COVID-19 pandemic, this court entered an order on May 27, 2020, temporarily amending SCR 217(2)(a) to provide a minimum interest rate of 0.65 percent until November 1, 2020. Considering the ongoing pandemic, we extend the temporary amendment of SCR 217(2)(a) to provide a minimum interest rate of 0.65 percent to June 1, 2021.
