



On December 6, 2002, appellant submitted a proper person motion entitled "Motion for Leave to File Motion to Release Pending Appeal; Motion to Compel Specific Performance; and Judicial Notice" ("motion for leave to file motion").<sup>1</sup> Because we elect to resolve this motion on the merits, we direct the clerk of this court to file the motion.

We note that appellant is represented by counsel in this appeal. Accordingly, we decline to grant him permission to file documents in proper person, and we deny the motion. In taking this matter under consideration, this court shall not consider the proposed "Motion to Release Pending Appeal; Motion to Compel Specific Performance; and Judicial Notice" attached to appellant's motion for leave to file motion. Appellant shall address all concerns regarding this appeal to counsel, and shall proceed through counsel in the prosecution of this appeal.
