During her lifetime, Ella E. Horst ("Ella") created a revocable trust, namely Ella E. Horst Revocable Trust u/a/h 05/21/1991 ("Trust"). Ella died on October 26, 2016. Upon her death, Patricia L. Horst ("Patricia") became the Successor Trustee of the Trust and has been administering the Trust since October 26, 2016. On January 27, 2017, Patricia provided Notice to Beneficiaries, Heirs and Interested Persons of Irrevocable Trust pursuant to NRS 164.021 ("Notice to Beneficiaries") and

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included represented that the Trust consisted of the initial trust dated May 21, 1991, the First Amendment to the Trust dated March 6, 1998, Second Amendment to the Trust dated March 16, 2004 and Third Amendment to the Trust dated September 26, 2005. More than a year after the Notice to Beneficiaries was served, Patricia, on May 9, 2018, filed a Petition to Assume In Rem Jurisdiction over Trust; Petition to Confirm Trust; Petition to Confirm Trustee: Petition for Instructions; and Petition for Removal of In Rem Jurisdiction over Trust ("Patricia's Petition"). Among other things, Patricia's Petition sought to have a handwritten note confirmed as the "Fourth" Amendment to the Trust. Brian filed his objection to Patricia's Petition and a counter-petition to remove Patricia as Successor Trustee, compel accounting and impose personal liability under NRS 165.138 and for instructions. Among other things, Brian's counter-petition questioned Patricia's administration of the Trust, alleged that undue influence was exerted relative the execution of the handwritten note which Patricia asserts is an amendment to the Trust, as well as the Second and Third Amendment to the Trust, and that undue influence and/or fraud may have played a part in the alleged significant depletion of Ella's Trust. The district court entered an order confirming the initial trust and the three amendments to the Trust and finding that the challenge of the Second and Third Amendment to the Trust was barred pursuant to NRS 164.021. The district court's order is an appealable order pursuant to NRS 164.030(4).



 - (d) Any information required to be included in the notice expressly provided by the trust instrument; and
 - (e) A statement set forth in a separate paragraph, in 12-point boldface type or an equivalent type which states: "You may not bring an action to contest the trust more than 120 days from the date this notice is served upon you."

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The trustee shall serve the notice pursuant to the provisions of NRS 155.010.

No person upon whom notice is served pursuant to this section may bring an action to contest the validity of the trust more than 120 days from the date the notice is served upon the person, unless the person proves that he or she did not receive actual notice.

Facts Presented

- Ella E. Horst (the "Deceased") died on October 26, 2016. At the date of death, she 13. was resident of Clark County, Nevada.
- Deceased created a trust named "Ella E. Horst Revocable Trust" on May 21, 1991, 14. (hereinafter referred to as the "Initial Trust").
 - 15. Deceased created a first amended on March 6, 1998.
 - Deceased created a second amendment on March 16, 2004 16.
- 17. Deceased created a Third amendment on September 26, 2005. The Trust and the first, second and third amendments may hereinafter be referred to as the "Trust."
 - 18. Objector is a beneficiary of the Trust.
- On January 27, 2017, pursuant to §164.021 provided Notice to Beneficiaries, Heirs 19. and Interested Persons of Irrevocable Trust regarding the Initial Trust and included the first, second and third amendments (hereinafter maybe referred to as the "Notice").
- No dispute exists as to whether the Notice compiled with NRS §164.021, or whether 20. Objector received actual notice.
- 21. The 120-day challenge period in NRS §164.021(4) expired on or about May 17, 2017.
- As stated in item one above, On May 9, 2018, Petitioner filed a pleading that 22. included a Petition to Confirm Trust, which requested the Court to confirm the Initial Trust, the first, second, and third amendments.
 - In the same pleading, Petitioner brought a Petition for Instructions, which asserted: 23.

 - 24. No dispute exists over the Initial Trust and the first amendment.
 - 25. Objector filed his objection on July 16, 2018, to the second and third amendments.

The Petition of Patricia L. Horst (hereinafter referred to as "Petitioner") to Confirm Trust, having this date come on for hearing, it appearing to the Court that:

Procedural Background

- Petitioner filed the Petition, with other Petitions on Friday, May 9, 2018, for a 1. hearing on May 25, 2018.
- 2. Gwen Rutar Mullins, Esq. filed on May 23, 2018 on behalf of Brian Holiday (herein after referred to as "Objector"), a Notice of Appearance and Request Pursuant to EDCR 4.08 to Have Matter Heard Before a Probate Judge.
- At the hearing on May 25, 2018, the Probate Commissioner referred the matter to a 3. Probate Judge.
- On July 16, 2018, Objector filed an Objection to Petitioner petitions referred to in 4. item 1 herein.
 - This Court set this matter for a hearing on August 2, 2018. 5.
 - On July 31, 2018, Petitioner's and Objector's legal counsels submitted a Stipulation 6.

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and Order to Continue Hearing. This Court reset the hearing to September 13, 2018 at 9:30 AM.

- Petitioner filed on August 8, 2018, a Response to Objector's Objections referred to 7. in Averment 4.
 - 8. Objector filed a Reply on August 31, 2018 on his Counter-Petitions.
- 9. The Petition, the Objection, Response, and Reply, were initially heard before this Court on September 13, 2018, which resulted in the Order on Patricia A Horst's Petition, Opposition to Patricia A Horst's Petition, and Counter Petition, court-clerk filed stamped October 17, 2018. In the Order this Court, among other matters assumed jurisdiction over the trust, and confirmed Petitioner as trustee and opened discovery. During the hearing the Court deferred on ruling on confirming the Second and Third Amendments to the Trust for the parties to resolve the dispute over the same.
- The Court issued on October 5, 2018, an Order Scheduling Status Check for October 10. 17, 2018, at 10:30 AM revolving the Second and Third Amendments to the Initial Trust.

Issue Presented

Whether NRS §164.021(4) bars a challenge to a trust and amendment after a proper 11. notice of irrevocability was provided, where after the expiration of the 120-day notice period a hand written note is asserted to be an amendment via a petition for instructions?

Legal Authority

12. NRS §164.021 (2009) provides:

Notice by trustee to beneficiary concerning change of revocable trust to irrevocable trust; contents of notice; limitation of action to contest validity of trust.

- When a revocable trust becomes irrevocable because of the death of a settlor or by the express terms of the trust, the trustee may, after the trust becomes irrevocable, provide notice to any beneficiary of the irrevocable trust, any heir of the settlor or to any other interested person.
- The notice provided by the trustee must contain:
 - (a) The identity of the settlor of the trust and the date of execution of the trust instrument:
 - (b) The name, mailing address and telephone number of any trustee of the trust;
 - (c) Any provision of the trust instrument which pertains to the beneficiary or notice that the heir or interested person is not a beneficiary under the trust;
 - (d) Any information required to be included in the notice expressly provided by the trust instrument; and
 - (e) A statement set forth in a separate paragraph, in 12-point boldface type or an equivalent type which states: "You may not bring an action to contest the trust more than 120 days from the date this notice is served upon you."

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The trustee shall serve the notice pursuant to the provisions of NRS 155.010.

No person upon whom notice is served pursuant to this section may bring an action to contest the validity of the trust more than 120 days from the date the notice is served upon the person, unless the person proves that he or she did not receive actual notice.

Facts Presented

- Ella E. Horst (the "Deceased") died on October 26, 2016. At the date of death, she was resident of Clark County, Nevada.
- Deceased created a trust named "Ella E. Horst Revocable Trust" on May 21, 1991, (hereinafter referred to as the "Initial Trust").
 - Deceased created a first amended on March 6, 1998.
 - Deceased created a second amendment on March 16, 2004
- Deceased created a Third amendment on September 26, 2005. The Trust and the first, second and third amendments may hereinafter be referred to as the "Trust."
 - Objector is a beneficiary of the Trust.
- On January 27, 2017, pursuant to §164.021 provided Notice to Beneficiaries, Heirs and Interested Persons of Irrevocable Trust regarding the Initial Trust and included the first, second and third amendments (hereinafter maybe referred to as the "Notice").
- No dispute exists as to whether the Notice compiled with NRS §164.021, or whether Objector received actual notice.
- The 120-day challenge period in NRS §164.021(4) expired on or about May 17,
- As stated in item one above, On May 9, 2018, Petitioner filed a pleading that included a Petition to Confirm Trust, which requested the Court to confirm the Initial Trust, the first, second, and third amendments.
 - In the same pleading, Petitioner brought a Petition for Instructions, which asserted:
- NRS §164.030(1) provides "any trustee...may petition the court for instructions in the administration of the trust or for a construction of the trust instrument." The relevant averments in the Petition for Instructions are provided:
 - a. NRS §153.031(1)(b) and (d) provides that Petitioner as trustee "may petition

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the court regarding any aspect of the affairs of the trust, including:

(b) Determining the construction of the trust instrument;

(d) Determining the validity of a provision of the trust;

b. On October 11, 2011, Ella E. Horst handwrote a letter to the Trust which reads, "I purchased Stella Adkins interest in the property at 7475 W Rosada Way - Las Vegas Nevada 89149. This share is to be added to my other share and go to Patricia Horst." This letter was witnessed by Elizabeth A. Mendre.

- c. Petitioner believes the letter is an amendment to the Trust, because it refers to the Trust, describes the Property subject to the Trust, and describes the distribution of the Property.
- d. Thus, Petitioner believes this Honorable Court's confirmation of the addition of the one-quarter (25%) acquired interest to the original one-half (50%) interest to create a threequarter (75%) interest in the Property and distribution to Patricia Lynn Horst of the undivided three-quarter (75%) interest of the trust in and to the Property is appropriate.
 - No dispute exists over the Initial Trust and the first amendment. 24.
 - 25. Objector filed his objection on July 16, 2018, to the second and third amendments.

Legal Arguments

- 26. Objector asserts the Petition for Instructions is a notice under §164.021, and thus renews or starts a 120-day challenge period thereunder for the Trust and all amendments, and as such, his objection is proper and the second and third amendment should not be confirmed. In support of Objector's claim, he asserts had he known of the handwritten letter, he would have surely challenged the second and third amendments.
- Petitioner asserts the Petition for Instructions is not a Notice under §164.021, but 27. instead is a request for construction and verification of a provision of trust; that proper notice was given to Objector for the Initial Trust, first, second and third amendments; his filed Objection on July 16, 2018, was after May 17, 2017, the end of the 120-day challenge period provided under §164.021(4), and thus the initial trust, first, second and third amendments should be confirmed.

Findings

- 28. There is no dispute as to the Initial Trust and the First Amendment.
- 29. The only one exception to §164.021(4) is where a beneficiary has not received actual notice. In the case at bar, the Objector did not assert he lacked actual notice, as such, Objector is found to have possessed actual knowledge.
- 30. There is no case law interpreting whether the 120-day challenge period under NRS §164.021(4), as Objector asserts, starts another 120-day notice period to challenge all documents previously provided pursuant NRS §164.021, where a petition for instructions is presented introducing a proposed additional amendment.

Order

NOW THEREFORE, good cause appearing, it is hereby:

ORDERED the Ella E. Horst Revocable Trust" on May 21, 1991 is confirmed, valid, and enforceable.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED the First Amendment, dated on March 6, 1998, of the Ella E. Horst Revocable Trust is confirmed, valid, and enforceable.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED the the Second Amendment, dated March 16, 2004, of the Ella E. Horst Revocable Trust is confirmed, valid, and enforceable.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Third Amendment, dated September 26, 2005, of the Ella E. Horst Revocable Trust is confirmed, valid, and enforceable.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED this Court's finding 8 in the Order On Patricia A. Horst's Petitions, Opposition to Patricia A. Horst's Petition and Counter Petition dated October 17, 2018, that "[d]iscovery is needed regarding the Second and Third Amendment to the Trust" is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following language: Discovery is needed regarding issues related to the October 2011 letter and undue influence."

Court stated concern regarding the 2011 letter and what affect it had on the trust, the issue of undue influence, and the breach of fiduciary duty. COURT THEREFORE ORDERED, Forensic Accounting DENIED; decision regarding the second and third amendments CONTINUED as it appeared discovery was needed, Mr. Kaplan to file an accounting within 60 days; Court RETAINS JURISDICTION over the trust, Trustee CONFIRMED.

- Mr. Kaplan stated he wanted to conform the first, second, third, and fourth amendments to the trust.

Ms. Mullins stated they objected to all assets being directed toward Patricia Horst as they should be going to all three kids and argued that Ms. Horst had access to all documentation and wouldn't disclose.

Mr. Kaplan argued that adding another document or amendment to the trust did not allow a challenge for the entire trust, that the beneficiaries didn't object to the first and second amendments and now they were challenging the third; however they must challenge within 120 days.

Court stated the trust became irrevocable upon the death of Ella Horst, that any challenges must be done within the 120 days and further inquired if the amendment dates were set out anywhere of if they happened over a number of years.

Mr. Davis argued notice must be included for any change of the trust, that notice was faulty since it didn't include all parts that effected his client, and that it was sent piece by piece.

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Mr. Kaplan argued he didn't have to include the entire trust in the notice.

Court stated notice must contain any information or provision of the trust that pertains to the beneficiary or that the heir was not a beneficiary.

Mr. Kaplan stated the parties only had the ability to challenge the fourth amendment of the trust.

Court stated the evolution of the trust was important.

Mr. Kaplan argued they where requesting to challenge the second and third amendments and that they were time barred; however they could conduct discovery on the rest.

Mr. Davis argued they took a little more with each amendment to the trust and that each one had an additional 120 days to object.

COURT FINDS the second and third amendments cannot be challenged as the 120 days ran; however later amendments were discoverable regarding how the trust evolved and how the fourth amendment happened AND THEREFORE ORDERED, Discovery allowed; however no challenge to the second and third amendments as they were time barred; Mr. Kaplan to prepare the order.
