*ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO STRIKE AND  
REGARDING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME*

Respondents have filed a motion to strike appellants' appendix on the basis that some of the page numbers are illegible, the index does not indicate the volume number of the appendix where each document is located, the index combines some separate filings, and the volumes of the appendix are not labeled on the covers. Appellants oppose the motion and respondents have filed a reply.

Review of the index reveals that it is deficient because it does not indicate the volume number of the appendix where each document is located and combines some separate filings. See NRAP 30(c)(2). Further, respondents correctly point out that some page numbers in the appendix are illegible.<sup>1</sup> Accordingly, the motion to strike is granted. The clerk shall strike the appendix filed on September 30, 2019.

<sup>1</sup>The volumes of the appendix are each labeled with volume numbers, contrary to respondents' assertion.

Appellants shall have 7 days from the date of this order to file and serve an amended appendix that contains legible page numbers on all pages and an index that fully complies with NRAP 30(c)(2).

Respondents' motion for a second extension of time to file the answering brief is granted to the following extent. Respondents shall have 21 days from the date of this order to file and serve the answering brief.

It is so ORDERED.
