*ORDER EXTENDING STAY OF REMITTITUR*

This court granted appellant's motion to stay issuance of the remittitur, until October 11, 2022, pending the filing of a petition for a writ of certiorari with the United States Supreme Court. See NRAP 41(b)(3). The clerk of the United States Supreme Court has now filed a notice informing this court that appellant has been granted an extension of time until October 15, 2022, to file a petition for a writ of certiorari. Accordingly, the stay of issuance of the remittitur is hereby extended until October 31, 2022. If the clerk of this court receives written notice by October 31, 2022, from the clerk of the United States Supreme Court that appellant has filed a petition for a writ of certiorari, the stay shall continue in effect until final disposition of the certiorari proceedings. If such notice is not received by October 31, 2022, the remittitur shall issue.
