ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO STAY ISSUANCE OF REMITTITUR

This court previously extended the stay of issuance of the remittitur until October 31, 2022, pending appellant's filing of a petition for a writ of certiorari with the United States Supreme Court. This court stated that if written notice was received by October 31, 2022, from the clerk of the United States Supreme Court that appellant has filed a petition for a writ of certiorari, the stay was to continue in effect until final disposition of the certiorari proceedings. If such notice was not received by October 31, 2022, the remittitur was to issue. To date, the United States Supreme Court has not filed a notice indicating that appellant has filed a petition for a writ of certiorari. However, appellant has now filed a motion representing that he filed a petition on October 15, 2022, and asking to stay issuance of the remittitur pending final disposition of that petition. The docket entries of the United States Supreme Court confirm that appellant filed a petition for a writ of certiorari on October 15, 2022. Under these circumstances, appellant's motion is granted. NRAP 41(b)(3)(B). Issuance of the remittitur is hereby stayed until final disposition of the certiorari proceedings.
