





Ms. Schifalacqua stated there was also outstanding surveillance, underlying data with latent print examinations, and underlying gun analysis of which she anticipated getting the first week of trial and requested parties have a conference call to sort out scheduling.

Mr. Hughes requested to withdraw as counsel and the Court to appoint Ms. Hua as counsel for the Deft's appeal. COURT SO ORDERED.
