ORDER GRANTING MOTION AND REJECTING BRIEF

Cause appearing, and despite its untimeliness, the motion for an extension of time filed on October 25, 2019, is granted. NRAP 31(b)(3). Appellant shall have 7 days from the date of this order to file and serve a brief that complies with the requirements of NRAP 28(a) and NRAP 32 and that includes proof of service of the brief on respondent. Failure to timely file the opening brief may result in the imposition of sanctions.
