Please be advised that from this date forward your authority as Attorney of Record is terminated. All of the professional relations of attorney and client with the above-named client is ended. I would respectfully remind you that state law gives me this right. Nev. Rev. Stat. 7.055, provides that:

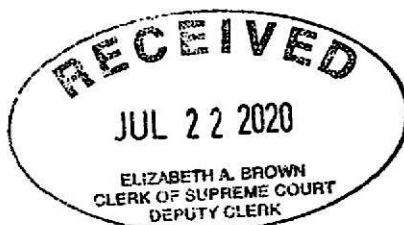
An attorney who has been discharged by his client shall, upon demand ... immediately deliver to the client all papers, documents, pleadings and items of tangible personal property which belong to or were prepared for that client.

See also Nev. Sup. Ct. Rule 166(4):

Upon termination of representation, a lawyer shall take steps to the extent reasonably practicable to protect a client's interest, such as ... surrendering papers and property to which the client is entitled ...".

As you know, pursuit of post-conviction claims are governed by strict time deadlines. Therefore, I cannot stress enough the importance of your providing my file to me as soon as possible. Your prompt attention to this very important matter is greatly appreciated.


