*ORDER GRANTING MOTION, DIRECTING PAYMENT FOR  
TRANSCRIPT, AND REGARDING BRIEFING*

Court recorder Rebeca Gomez has filed a motion for an extension of time to file the requested transcript. Ms. Gomez represents that appellants in Docket No. 78078 have not yet paid for the transcript. Cause appearing, the motion is granted. See NRAP 9(c)(4). Ms. Gomez shall have until December 27, 2019, to file the requested transcript in the district court and deliver copies to the requesting party. See NRAP 9(c)(1)(A). Within the same time period Ms. Gomez shall file a notice with this court that the completed transcript has been filed and delivered. The notice must comply with NRAP 9(c)(2).

Counsel for appellants in Docket No. 78078 shall have 7 days from the date of this order to pay the required fee and provide this court with written proof of payment. Failure to timely comply with this order may result in the imposition of sanctions.

Given this extension of time to file the requested transcript, the briefing schedule is modified as follows. Appellants in Docket No. 78078 shall have 90 days from the date of this order to file and serve the opening brief and appendix. Thereafter, briefing shall proceed in accordance with this court's October 15, 2019, order. Failure to timely file the opening brief

and appendix may result in the imposition of sanctions, including the dismissal of this appeal. NRAP 31(d).

It is so ORDERED.
