ORDER GRANTING MOTION, DIRECTING PAYMENT FOR TRANSCRIPT, AND REGARDING BRIEFING

Given this extension of time to file the requested transcript, the briefing schedule is modified as follows. Appellants in Docket No. 78078 shall have 90 days from the date of this order to file and serve the opening brief and appendix. Thereafter, briefing shall proceed in accordance with this court's October 15, 2019, order. Failure to timely file the opening brief

and appendix may result in the imposition of sanctions, including the dismissal of this appeal. NRAP 31(d).
