Respondents/Cross-Appellants, ANDREW M. CASH, M.D.; ANDREW M. CASH, M.D., P.C., aka ANDREW MILLER CASH, M.D., P.C.; and DESERT INSTITUTE OF SPINE CARE, LLC hereby moves this Court for an Order Extending the time for Respondents/Cross-Appellants to file its Answering Brief by 30 days pursuant to Rule 31(b)(3) of the Nevada Rules of Appellant Procedure. This is Respondents/Cross-Appellants second requested extension of time to file its Answering Brief and Appendix. The Court previously approved a first telephonic request, extending the time for filing Respondents/Cross-Appellants' Answering Brief until March 6, 2020. Accordingly, no prior requests have been denied or denied in part.

This Motion is supported by the attached Memorandum of Points and Authorities as well as the records, pleadings, and papers on file herein and any other evidence and oral argument this Court may entertain at the hearing of this Motion.

INTRODUCTION

Appellant filed its Notice of Appeal with the district court on April 10, 2019 and with the Supreme Court of Nevada on April 15, 2019. On April 15, 2019, the Supreme Court of Nevada referred the case to the Settlement Program. The parties participated in an in-person settlement conference on July 12, 2019. The Settlement Program judge notified this Court of the unsuccessful conference and this Court ordered on July 18, 2019 that Appellant's Opening Brief and Appendix were due on October 16, 2019.

Beginning on October 15, 2019, Appellant filed a series of requests for extension of time to submit its opening brief. Appellant filed a total of four requests, none of which were denied or denied in part. After Appellants' Opening Brief was filed on February 5, 2020 Respondents/Cross-Appellants' Answering Brief was due to be filed on March 6, 2020. Due to counsels' presence in two trials in the month of February, Respondents/Cross-Appellants requested one telephonic extension of time on February 12, 2020. Respondents/Cross-Appellants' request was granted, thus extending the due date for Respondents/Cross-Appellants' Answering Brief to March 20, 2020. To date, no request for extension has been denied or denied in part.

Despite the best efforts of Respondents/Cross-Appellants' counsel, Respondents/Cross-Appellants require additional time to file its Answering Brief and Appendix, and requests and extension of 30 days, until April 20, 2020, to do so. This motion is unopposed by Appellant and Appellant has agreed to a 30 day extension given the circumstances. Effective April 1, 2020, Carroll, Kelly, Trotter, Franzen & McBride will no longer be in Las Vegas and counsel for Respondents/Cross-Appellants' office will now be McBride Hall. Given the transitional period for the new law firm, Respondents/Cross-Appellants' counsel is facing extraordinary circumstances justifying an extension of time. A short 30 day

extension is requested to allow counsel to address the transitioning of law firms.

II.

LEGAL ARGUMENT

Pursuant to NRAP 26(b)(1), the Court may upon motion enlarge the time prescribed "to perform any act" by its order on a showing of good cause. NRAP 31(b), the rule governing extensions of time for filing briefs, requires that the request be made no later than the due date of the brief. Respondents/Cross-Appellants request an extension of 30 days, through April 20, 2020, to file the Answering Brief. NRAP31(b)(3). The original March 6, 2020 deadline was extended by telephonic request made to this Court. Respondents/Cross-Appellants have requested no other extensions. Without the requested extension, the brief would be due March 20, 2020.

Respondents/Cross-Appellants are unable to meet the March 20, 2020 deadline due and good cause exists for granting a 30 day extension. The transitional period as a result of Carroll, Kelly, Trotter, Franzen & McBride closing its Las Vegas office and the formation of McBride Hall as the new law firm for defense counsel has placed significant hardships on counsel during this transition period. The transition is effective April 1, 2020 and a 30 day extension would permit Respondents/Cross-Appellants' counsel the necessary time to adjust to these extraordinary circumstances and necessary, additional time to prepare the appropriate substitution of counsel on or around April 1st, review the record and prepare the Answering Brief. Additionally, counsel for Respondents/Cross-Appellants involved in overlapping trials for two and a half weeks during the month of February, which further created circumstances necessitating the brief extension.

Respondents/Cross-Appellants do not seek this extension in bad faith or to delay the proceedings. Additionally, counsel for the Appellant, Dave Barron, Esq., has advised that he has no objection to the proposed extension in light of the

1	internal transitions within the office of counsel for Respondents/Cross-Appellants.
2	On that basis, Respondents/Cross-Appellants respectfully request an extension of
3	30 days until April 20, 2020, to submit its Answering Brief and Appendix as the
4	reason for the requested extension constitutes good cause for an extension of time
5	under NRAP 26(b) and 31(b).
6	IV.
7	CONCLUSION
8	For the reasons stated herein, Respondents/Cross-Appellants respectfully
9	request an additional 30 days to submit its Answering Brief due to these
10	extraordinary circumstances.
