ORDER

On March 11, 2021, this court entered an order staying issuance of the remittitur until July 6, 2021, pursuant to NRAP 41(b)(3)(B). Respondents have filed a motion to extend the stay based on orders entered by the United States Supreme Court, in recognition of the impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic, granting parties 150 days to file a petition for a writ of certiorari. Respondents request that issuance of the remittitur be stayed until August 16, 2021, in order to allow for administrative processing. Appellant has filed an opposition and "Countermotion to Vacate Stay and Motion for Retroactive Extension of Response Deadline," arguing that respondents have not made a showing of a meritorious argument for

certiorari and the stay should be lifted altogether. This court declines to lift the stay at this point and the countermotion is denied. Respondents' motion for an extension is granted to the following extent. Issuance of the remittitur is stayed until July 30, 2021. If the clerk of this court receives written notice by July 30, 2021, from the clerk of the United States Supreme Court that appellant has filed a petition for a writ of certiorari, the stay shall continue in effect until final disposition of the certiorari proceedings. If notice is not received by July 30, 2021, the clerk shall issue the remittitur.
