MEMORANDUM OF POINTS AND AUTHORITIES

I. FACTUAL BACKGROUND AND PROCEDURAL HISTORY

1) Appellants' Notice of Appeal was filed on April 17, 2019.

- 2) Case 78624 was filed and docketed with the Nevada Supreme Court on April 24, 2019.
- 3) On June 4, 2019, this matter was removed from the Nevada Supreme Court Settlement Program and Appellants' Opening Brief became due 90 days later.
- On August 27, 2019, Appellants requested and received a telephonic extension to file their Opening Brief on September 17, 2019.
- 5) Lead counsel for Appellants is experiencing medical symptoms which are impeding his ability to finalize Appellants' Opening Brief. As such extraordinary and compelling circumstances exist pursuant to NRAP 26(b)(1)(B) for an additional 7 days for Appellants to file their Opening Brief.

II. LEGAL ARGUMENT

The Nevada Rules of Appellate Procedure provide that the time to perform any act may be extended by order of this court. NRAP 26(b). Pursuant to NRAP 26(b)(1)(B), Appellants submit that extraordinary and compelling circumstances exist to further extend the time for them to file Appellants' Opening Brief. Specifically, lead counsel for Appellants lives with a chronic medical condition which is associated with occasional but severe symptoms. *Exhibit 1*, Declaration of Michael N. Beede. Appellants' Counsel is currently experiencing such symptoms, rendering him unable to finalize Appellants' Opening Brief to the best of his ability. *Id.* Appellants' Opening Brief is largely completed, and Appellants' Counsel requests only a short extension of time to allow for his symptoms to subside.
