	In an order issued on November 14, 2019, the Court requested that the Appellants show

26	Leave and Additional Time to Cure and Jurisdictional Defects by Stipulation, Motion or Order	
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28	in the District Court on December 16, 2019 at nearly 11 p.m. By order of this Court,	
20	Respondents had 14 days to reply to Appellants'	response. This put Respondents on a tight

Finally, Respondents have not previously requested any extensions on deadlines in this matter, before today.

Respondents request permission to file the Reply after the deadline. The original deadline was December 30, 2019. Respondent requests an extension of time to file the Reply on January 3, 2020.
