ORDER REGARDING MOTIONS

Appellant has filed a motion for leave to file an opening brief that exceeds the type-volume limitation in NRAP 32(a)(7)(A)(ii) by 4,638 words. Respondents oppose the motion and countermove to dismiss this appeal. The opening brief was electronically filed and served on December 4, 2019. Having reviewed the parties' filings, this court grants the motion to exceed the type-volume limitation, denies respondents' counter-motion to dismiss the appeal, denies appellant's motion to strike respondents' reply in support of their counter-motion, and denies as moot respondents' counter-motion to submit a five-page reply.

The motion for an extension of time to file the answering brief is granted. NRAP 31(b)(3)(B). Respondents shall have 60 days from the date of this order to file and serve the answering brief.

Appellant's unopposed motion to file portions of the opening brief and appendix under seal is granted. *See* SRCR 7. The clerk shall file the portions of the opening brief and volumes 51 and 52 of the appendix, received on December 10, 2019, under seal.

It is so ORDERED.
