MOTION FOR EXTENSTION OF TIME TO FILE OPENING BRIEF (SECOND REQUEST)

COMES NOW, Appellant Michael McNair, by and through his attorney, Navid Afshar, Deputy Special Public Defender, and requests this Honorable Court to grant an extension of time to file the opening brief and appendix in this matter. This is Appellant's second request for an extension of time to file his Opening Brief and appendix.

STATEMENT OF THE CASE

This is an appeal from a judgment of conviction of First Degree Murder with Use of a Deadly Weapon and Carrying a Concealed Firearm or Other Deadly Weapon. Mr. McNair was charged by way of Information with Murder with use of a deadly weapon and Carrying Concealed Firearm or other deadly weapon on October 24, 2017. He proceeded to trial and the jury returned a verdict of guilty as to First Degree Murder with use of a deadly weapon and Carrying a Concealed Firearm or other deadly weapon. The district court sentenced Mr. McNair on May 1, 2019 to 20 years to Life plus a consecutive term of 60-240 months for the use of the deadly weapon and a concurrent sentence for Count 2. The Judgment of Conviction was filed May 3, 2019 and the Notice of Appeal was timely filed on May 22, 2019.

McNair filed his first request for an extension of time to file his Opening Brief on September 30, 2019. The Court's Order granting the motion was filed October 10, 2019. The Opening Brief is due December 30, 2019.

Based on the reasons set forth in the declaration attached hereto, counsel for Appellant is requesting an extension of time to file the Opening Brief. It is respectfully requested that this Court grant this second request for a continuance of 45 days for Appellant to file the Opening Brief and Appendix, up to and including February 13, 2019.

POINTS AND AUTHORITIES

NRAP 31(b)(3)(B) sets forth in pertinent part:

A motion for extension of time for filing a brief may be made no later than the due date for the brief.....

(B) ...The court will grant an initial motion for extension of time for filing a brief only upon a clear showing of good cause. The court shall not grant additional extensions of time except upon a showing of extraordinary circumstances and extreme need.

CONCLUSION

Based on the Declaration attached hereto, Mr. McNair requests the Court grant his motion for an extension of time to file the Opening Brief and Appendix, up to and including February 13, 2019.
