COMES NOW, Appellant Michael McNair, by and through his attorneys, JoNell Thomas, Special Public Defender, and Navid Afshar, Deputy Special Public Defender, and requests this Honorable Court to grant an extension of time to Appellant Michael McNair, to comply with the procedures set forth in NRAP 12A as ordered in this Court's Order filed March 5, 2020. This is Appellant's first request for an extension of time and this request is for 60 days, up to and including June 23, 2020.

STATEMENT OF THE CASE

This is an appeal from a judgment of conviction of First Degree Murder with Use of a Deadly Weapon and Carrying a Concealed Firearm or Other Deadly Weapon. The Judgment of Conviction was filed May 3, 2019 and the Notice of Appeal was timely filed on May 22, 2019. The appeal was docketed in the Supreme Court and the Opening Brief and Appendix were due February 13, 2020.

On February 11, 2020, McNair filed a Motion and Stipulation to Request to Stay the Appeal and Remand this Matter to the District Court for Entry of Plea which also was signed by Alexander Chen of the Clark County District Attorney's Office. On March 5, 2020, this Court filed its Order which stated in pertinent part:

This court declines to remand this matter at this time. If the district court is included to grant the relief requested, then it may certify its intent to do so, and appellant may file a motion in this court, with the district court's certification attached, seeking a remand to the district court to grant the requested relief. See NRAP 12A.....

A hearing was held in the district court on March 12, 2020. The Honorable Judge Douglas Herndon certified that it intends to vacate the Judgment of Conviction filed in Case No. C-17-327395-1 against Mr. McNair, and accept his entry of plea pursuant to the parties' stipulated agreement. An Order has been prepared and provided to the District Attorney, Alex Chen, to review and sign off as approved. Respondent is still reviewing.

Based on the reasons set forth in the declaration attached hereto, counsel for Appellant is requesting an extension of time to comply with this Court's Order dated March 5, 2020.

NRAP 12A sets forth the procedure if a motion is made in the district court for relief that the court lacks authority to grant because an appeal has been docketed.

CONCLUSION
