ORDER GRANTING MOTIONS

Real parties in interest Sig Rogich and Imitations, LLC (collectively the Rogich parties) have filed an emergency motion for a second extension of time to file an answer against the petition, again on the ground that the district court is expected to rule shortly on the Rogich parties' motion for summary judgment. In addition, the district court is expected to rule on Eldorado Hills, LLC's motion to dismiss and for summary judgment. The Rogich parties contend that the petition may become moot if the district court grants their and Eldorado's motions.

Eldorado Hills does not oppose the motion for an extension but asks to be permitted to file its answer to the writ 10 days after service of the Rogich parties' answer. Petitioner opposes both motions objecting to further delay in the instant proceedings and on the ground that the writ petition may not be rendered moot. The Rogich parties have filed a reply.

The motions are granted. The Rogich parties shall have until October 31, 2019, to file and serve an answer to the petition. Eldorado Hills shall have 10 days from the date of service of the Rogich parties' answer to file an answer to the petition. Petitioner shall have 14 days from service of the last filed answer to file and serve any reply. Failure to timely comply with this order may result in the imposition of sanctions.

It is so ORDERED.¹
