ORDER DENYING STAY

This is a pro se appeal from a district court order resolving a petition for instructions in the administration of a trust. Appellant has filed a motion to stay the district court's order pending appeal, and respondent Dunham Trust Company opposes the motion. Respondent Caroline Davis has filed a document indicating that she agrees with Dunham's position.

When considering a motion for a stay pending appeal, this court considers the following factors: whether (1) the object of the appeal will be defeated absent a stay, (2) appellant will suffer irreparable or serious harm without a stay, (3) respondent will suffer irreparable or serious harm if a stay is granted, and (4) appellant is likely to prevail on the merits of the appeal. Having considered the parties' arguments in light of these factors,

this court concludes that appellant has not demonstrated that these factors militate in favor of a stay. Accordingly, the motion for stay is denied.¹

It is so ORDERED.
