

ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO STRIKE

Real parties in interest filed their reply in support of petition for writ of mandamus and/or prohibition on September 11, 2019. Real parties in interest have now filed a "Notice of Intent to Rely on Supplement to the Record in Plaintiff-Petitioner's Reply Brief." Therein, real parties purport to submit a January 14, 2020, email from the Office of the Labor Commissioner and inform counsel for petitioners that real parties intend to use the email in support of their argument. Petitioners move to strike the notice, contending that it is an unauthorized supplemental brief that attempts to improperly augment the record with hearsay that was not part

of the district court record. The unopposed motion to strike is granted. The clerk shall strike the notice filed on January 22, 2020.
