



ORDER GRANTING MOTIONS TO ASSOCIATE COUNSEL

Appellant has filed motions to associate attorneys Peter W. Bloom and Linda S. Wendell Hsu of Selman Brightman, LLP pursuant to SCR 42. Attached to the motions to associate are verified applications for each attorney, certificates of good standing for both attorneys from the State Bar of California, and Supreme Court Rule 42 statements.

The Rule 42 statements of the State Bar of Nevada indicate that neither Mr. Bloom nor Ms. Wendell Hsu has previously applied to appear in Nevada courts within the past three years. *See* SCR 42(6) (repeated appearances by any person or firm pursuant to this rule shall be cause for denial of a motion). Cause appearing, the motions are granted. Mr. Bloom and Ms. Wendell Hsu shall be permitted to appear on behalf of appellant. Nevada attorney Gil Glancz of Selman Brightman, LLP, shall be responsible for all matters presented by Mr. Bloom and Ms. Wendell Hsu in this matter. *See* SCR 42(14); NRAP 25(a)(5) (all documents submitted to the supreme court for filing by a represented party shall include the original

signature of at least one attorney of record who is an active member of the State Bar of Nevada).

It is so ORDERED.
