MEMORANDUM OF POINTS AND AUTHORITIES

Pursuant to Rule 3(1) of the Nevada Supreme Court's Rules Governing Sealing and Redacting of Records ("SRCR"), "[a]ny person may request that the court seal or redact court records for a case that is subject to these rules by filing a written motion" A court may order the records redacted or sealed provided that "the court makes and enters written findings that the specific sealing or redaction is justified by identified compelling privacy or safety interest that outweigh the public interest in access to the court records," which includes a finding that "[t]he sealing or redaction is permitted or required by federal or state law." SRCR 3(4)(a).

NRS 239B.030 provides that a person shall not include "any personal information about a person on any document that is recorded, filed or otherwise submitted to [a] governmental agency."
