Appellant The State of Nevada Department of Business and Industry, Financial Institutions Division ("FID") requests a 30-day extension through August 19, 2020, to file the reply brief pursuant to NRAP 31(b)(3). This is the first motion for extension of the reply brief. (The parties previously stipulated to extend the deadline pursuant to NRAP 31(b)(2)). The reply brief was originally due June 19, 2020 and, without an extension, would be due July 19, 2020. This motion is timely and brought for good cause.
