**MOTION TO EXCEED PAGE LIMIT FOR
“MOTION TO STRIKE ARGUMENTS RAISED FOR THE FIRST TIME
ON APPEAL AND FOR THE FIRST TIME IN REPLY”**

Respondent TitleMax of Nevada, Inc. requests leave under NRAP 27(d)(2) and NRAP 32(a)(7)(D) to file a motion to strike arguments appellant FID raised for the first time on appeal in excess of ten pages. The motion to strike is 14 pages long. The additional pages are needed to address the FID’s new arguments and provide appendix citations to numerous documents that demonstrate the falsity of the FID’s arguments.
