APPELLANT'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

TO FILE OPPOSITION TO MOTION TO STRIKE

Appellant moves this Court, pursuant to NRAP 26(b)(1)(A), for a one (1) week enlargement of time from the current due date of December 14, 2020, up to and including December 21, 2020, within which to file its opposition to Respondent's Motion to Strike. The opposition was originally due on November 26, 2020. Appellants requested a telephonic extension resulting in the opposition being due on December 14, 2020.

Appellant brings this motion in good faith and not for the purpose of delay. The Nevada Rules of Appellate Procedure permit this Court to extend deadlines or permit an act after a deadline has expired contingent upon a showing of good cause. NRAP 26(b)(1)(A). This extension is necessary due to the significant disruption in

operations to Appellant's counsel as a result of the COVID crisis over the past several months causing workflow issues, as well as unexpected computer issues more recently, amounting to extraordinary circumstances.

The opposition is substantially complete. Appellant seeks this brief extension in order to provide this Court with a cogent and succinct opposition.

Appellant does not believe that the requested extension will adversely affect Respondent.

For the reasons stated above, Appellant respectfully requests a one (1) week extension of time, until December 21, 2020, to finalize and submit the opposition.
