

ORDER GRANTING MOTION

Extraordinary and compelling circumstances having been shown, respondent's motion requesting a second extension of time to file the answering brief is granted. NRAP 26(b)(1)(B). Respondent shall have until June 29, 2020, to file and serve the answering brief. Any additional extensions will be granted only on showing of extraordinary and compelling circumstances. *Id.* Counsel's caseload normally will not be deemed such a circumstance. *Cf. Varnum v. Grady*, 90 Nev. 374, 528 P.2d 1027 (1974). Failure to timely file the answering may result in the imposition of sanctions, including disposition of this appeal without an answering brief from respondent.
