





ORDER DIRECTING ANSWER

This original petition for a writ of mandamus challenges an order from a Southern Nevada Disciplinary Board hearing panel granting the State Bar of Nevada's motion to strike petitioner Lynn Shoen's petition for reinstatement. Therefore, respondent shall have 28 days from the date of this order within which to file and serve an answer, including authorities, against issuance of the requested writ. NRAP 21(b)(1).
