ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO STAY ISSUANCE OF REMITTITUR

Appellants have filed a motion to stay issuance of the remittitur pending the filing of a petition for a writ of certiorari to the United States Supreme Court. The motion is granted. *See* NRAP 41(b)(3). Issuance of the remittitur is stayed until February 8, 2022. If the clerk of this court receives written notice by February 8, 2022, from the clerk of the United States Supreme Court that appellants have filed a petition for a writ of certiorari, the stay shall continue in effect until final disposition of the certiorari proceedings. If notice is not received by February 8, 2022, the clerk shall issue the remittitur.
